(CRAIGLANDS COURT, ALDCLIFFE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over the damaged cattle grid on Craiglands Court, Aldcliffe between Aldcliffe Hall Lane and Oaklands Court.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Monday 4th December 2023 until 2359 hours on Sunday 24th December 2023 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Aldcliffe Hall Road – Oaklands Court and vice versa.

Access for pedestrians and cycles will be maintained via the cattle grid bypass gate.

The temporary prohibition is necessary due to a damaged cattle grid.
